Attached is the Annual Report pursuant to the requirements of the Ventura County Municipal Stormwater NPDES Permit No. CAS004002/Order No. 10-108 which requires an Annual Storm Water Report (Report) to be submitted by December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. This Report discusses the Permittees' Permit compliance activities for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 and includes a description of all activities conducted during the reporting period, an assessment of the Ventura Countywide Stormwater Program's effectiveness, and an evaluation of pollutants detected through the Stormwater Monitoring Program.

This Annual Report was prepared with the cooperation and assistance of the Ventura Countywide Permittees which includes the cities of Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Ventura, Santa Paula, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, the County of Ventura, and the Ventura County Watershed Protection District. Each Permittee contributed detailed Permit compliance information and data regarding their various stormwater programs.

Beach water quality in Ventura County was once again among the best in the state. Some notable accomplishments by the Program and the Permittees this reporting period include: submittal of the Program's Report of Waste Discharge, continuation of a bacteria genetic source marker study, completion of a unified countywide geodatabase storm drain atlas for future watershed planning efforts.
